Counseling Connection

This month we will be celebrating honesty at Woodland. Your child will be learning what honesty means and the different ways that people can be honest or dishonest. Outlined below, are our topics for each week:

- Week 1: Defining Honesty and Truth
- Week 2: Truth and Consequences
- Week 3: Being Fair to Yourself and Others
- Week 4: Honesty is Taking Only What Belongs to You

Please talk with your child at home about what he or she has learned. To further support the skills your child is learning, please see below for activities that you can do at home.

Suggested Activities:

- Talk to your child about how honesty is important at your place of work. Explain what happens when people are dishonest.
- Watch the movie Pinocchio with your child and talk about what happens when Pinocchio tells a lie.
- Children often do not understand how their dishonesty can affect others. Explain to your child how others would feel if your child told a lie or if he or she picked up an item that did not belong to him or her. Point out situations where your child has suffered because of someone else's dishonesty, then discuss how he or she felt.
- Praise your child for being truthful, even if you don't like what he or she has told you. When your child is dishonest, let him or her know that you are disappointed.
- Let your child know that your ability to trust him or her depends on honesty. If your child is honest, you will trust him or her.
- When watching TV or videos with your child, point out who is being honest and dishonest and what happens as a consequence.

Social skills are essential for a successful future. Thank you for the opportunity to work with your child.
