2026-2027 SCHOOL SUCCESS PLAN GOALS

Goal 1: By May 2027, Woodland Elementary School will increase proficiency from the 2025-2026 scores of: ELA: 39%, Math: 41%, Science 41% to 50% proficiency in ELA, Math, and Science through Benchmark Aligned Explicit Instruction.

Goal 2: By May 2027, Woodland Elementary School will increase to 50% proficiency in literacy for our kindergarten, first, and second grade students from the 2025- 2026 school year data: kindergarten: 38%, first grade: 43%, second grade 38% by ensuring that all K-2 students receive explicit, systematic instruction in foundational reading skills with the goal of reading on grade level by the end of second grade.

Goal 3: By May 2027, Woodland Elementary School will increase proficiency for the identified ESSA Subgroups from the 2025- 2026 school year of SWD in ELA 12%, to 40% proficiency through Benchmark Aligned Instruction.

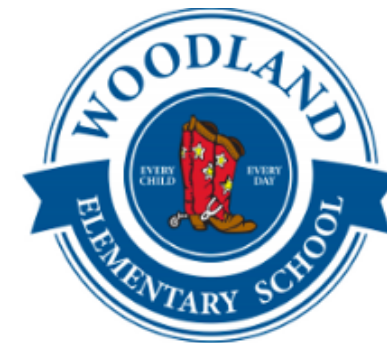

What is Title 1?

Woodland Elementary is identified as a Title 1 School as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title 1 is designed to support state and local schools reform efforts tied to the challenging state academic standards to improve teaching and learning for students. Title 1 programs must be based on the effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family engagement. All Title 1 schools must jointly develop, with parents and family members, a written parent and family engagement policy. Title I status is determined by the school's percentage of students on Free or Reduced Lunch.

What is it? This is the plan that describes how Woodland Elementary will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support learning. Woodland Elementary values the contributions and involvement of parents and family members to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes different ways that Woodland Elementary will support family engagement and how parents can help plan and participate in activities and events to promote student learning at school and at home.

How is it revised? Woodland Elementary invited all parents to attend our annual Title 1 parent input meeting last spring to review and revise our parent engagement plan, budget, compact and school-wide plan. Additionally, if you have input or comments regarding this plan during the school year please call or email mpineo@pasco.k12.fl.us. All parent feedback received throughout the year and from the parent input meeting will be used to revise this plan for the next school year. We also distribute an annual survey in February to ask parents for their feedback on this plan and on the use of funds for family engagement.

Who is it for? All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Woodland Elementary will provide full opportunity participation of parents and family members with Limited English, with disabilities, and migratory children.

Where is it available? This plan is sent home in the beginning of the school year with the Annual Title 1 letter. it is also available on our school website (wes.pasco.k12.fl.us) and in the Title 1 Family and Community Binder located in the office. Additional copies will be available at the school.

Woodland Elementary believes that family engagement means that participation of parents and family members in regular two-way, meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities, including ensuring that:

- Parents play an integral role in their child's learning.
- Parents are actively involved in their child's education at school.
- Parents are full partners in their child's education and are included, as appropriate, in decision-making and on advisory committees to assist in the education of their child.

SCHOOL PARENT COMPACT

As part of this plan, Woodland Elementary and our families will develop a school parent compact. This is an agreement that parents, teachers, and students will develop that explains how parents and teachers will work together to ensure all students reach grade-level benchmarks. The compact will be updated annually based on feedback from parents, students, and teachers during the Title 1 family input meeting. The school-parent compact is also shared with parents during parent- teacher conferences.

PARENT RESOURCE CENTER

Our Parent Resource Center is located in the school lobby and accessible at any time during the school hours.

Woodland Elementary will take the following measures to promote and support parents and family members as an important foundation of the school. In order to strengthen and reach our school goals, we will....

- help parents understand benchmarks, achievement levels of state and local assessments.
- help parents to understand how to monitor their child's progress and work with educators by offering parent conferences.
- build the capacity of school personnel and engage families and work together with them to obtain goals.
- coordinate and integrate Parent Engagement programs with other Federal, State, and local programs.
- offer a variety of communication platforms: weekly calls and emails, newsletters, weekly take home folder, school website, and social media.
- be dedicated to facilitating support for families within the community and positive parent engagement activities.
