
## **Materials:**

One deck of playing cards (Kings, Queens, Jacks, and Jokers removed)

## **Equation Mambo**

## **How To Play:**

- 1. Deal 5 cards to each player's hand
- 2. Place the remaining cards face down in the middle, and flip one card face up (this card is your target number)
- 3. Players must use the cards in their hand to create an equation to reach the target number. Players may use any combination of operations.



- 4. Players score points for the total number of cards used in their equation.
- 5. Each player places point cards to the side, draws back to 5, and a new target number is flipped over.
- 6. Continue until all cards are gone from the middle.
- 7. The player with the most points at the end wins.
- Variation 1: Jacks, Queens, and Kings can be added in to represent 11's, 12's, and 13's respectively.
- Variation 2: Set a 1 minute timer to create equations each round for players who are faster at manipulating numbers
